THESE STYLES ARE NOT A HIT FOR ANYONE!

- No clothing affiliated with a school, professional sports team, group, club, etc. (Chaperones will be permitted to wear school affiliated golf shirts or polos).
- No torn Clothing (not in good repair, clothing with holes, torn pants, shirts, etc)
- No Revealing clothing, Lycra, or Spandex, low riding pants (i.e. bathing suit tops or bottoms, cropped tops, Sheer/see-through clothing, etc)
- No Hats, Bandanas Doo-rags and/or Towels (Either worn or hanging from belt loops etc.)
- No Weapons, knives, laser pointers or chemical irritants are permitted.
- No Chains or spiked accessories • Oversized belts and necklaces
- Students or chaperones not following this guideline will be dealt with at the discretion of the Orange County Sheriff's Office.
- No Alcohol, tobacco products and controlled substances are allowed and will be confiscated and not returned if found onsite.
- No article of clothing with an area code on it
- No backpacks of any type, size or style (Small purses and hip bags are okay.)

What to wear under your gown:

- a) Dress shoes. **NO TENNIS SHOES.**
- b) Girls should wear a light color dress or skirt no longer than their gown and a blouse.
- c) Boys should wear dark dress slacks, collared shirt and tie (white shirt recommended). **NO JEANS**
